

TASE Tips for Candidates

This document offers practical guidance for candidates preparing to write the Trademark Agent Skills Exam. The tips below are intended to help you interpret questions carefully, organize your responses clearly, and make effective use of the time available during the exam.

- Read each question carefully and tailor your answer to the specific instructions provided.
- Ensure your response addresses all parts of the question, including any sub-questions.
- Read all of the sub-questions first before answering to avoid duplicating responses.
- Keep your answers clear and concise and use point form where permitted to save time.
- Rely on the information provided in the question and reconsider your approach if you find yourself assuming missing facts.
- Use the marks allotted to each question to help manage your time during the exam.
- Pay particular attention to questions requesting a specific number of answers. Provide your best answers up to the specific number of answers requested. Additional answers provided by candidates will NOT be marked. For example, if a question asks for 3 available types of intellectual property protection, only the first 3 responses will be marked.
